**The Golden Fidget**, Minegoziibe Anishnabe School, Grade 2/3 Class (Ojibwe from Pine Creek). Conceived, storyboarded and directed entirely by 8-10 year olds, *The Golden Fidget* is a playful take on old-style detective films. (Wapikoni Mobile, 2017, 7 min.).

**Pookums**, Director Shane Belcourt (Métis). A short film based on real events, made to test out a new camera. Shot in four days on a budget of \$150 (because the director bought the actors lunch). (2017, 11 min.).

**No Reservations**, Director Trevor Carroll (Anishinaabe from Wikwemikong). A satirical commentary inspired by the No DAPL movement. What if the moccasin was on the other foot? (Crazy8z Film Society, 2017, 12 min.)

**Is that one of Your Jokes?** Director Jay Cardinal Villeneuve (Cree/Métis). As we follow Mark Buffalo, an obscure First Nations comedian, trying to line up gigs in local bars and cafes, we see that life for a comedian is not always funny – at least not to him. (Adult language). (Cardinal Cinema Cartel, 2017, 11 min.).

**Ronnie BoDean**, Director Steven Paul Judd (Kiowa/Choctaw). Is it a problem when the babysitter teaches your kids three-card monte? Hell, no. It's a life skill. And "once you got skills, you can provide for your family." With Wes Studi as Ronnie BoDean. (2015, 13 min.).
